To apply for guardianship you will need 2 documents:

1. A doctor's letter identifying your son/daughter's disability or diagnosis. The letter also needs to state that a guardianship is needed due to your son/daughter's disability/diagnosis. If you are seeking full guardianship the letter must say "FULL" guardianship is needed. The letter needs to be an original.
2. A psychological evaluation/summary. This can be provided by your son/daughter's school. This can be an evaluation that was done in the past and it can be a copy.
